Nurse Coordinators are responsible for the day to day operation of the SAM site. Responsibilities include:

- Referral management and client assessments.
- Ongoing health assessment and counselling for clients and caregivers
- Participation in implementation of daily recreational program activities as required.
- Assisting clients with ADL's while promoting independence.
- Ongoing identification and management of any health/safety issues.
- Site record management.
- Site public relations.
